

### **The Winifred H. Dyer Scholarship**

The Winifred H. Dyer Scholarship Award was established in honor of Winifred Dyer, a former outstanding Utah School Administrator. The scholarship is given annually to a deserving female graduate student in the Masters degree or Administrative Licensure program in the Department of Educational Leadership and Policy at the University of Utah. (In the event there is no woman that meets the criteria, the scholarship can be awarded to a male student or not awarded at the discretion of the selection committee.) The criteria for selection include: financial need and exemplification of Winifred Dyer's professional life including factors such as service to students in K-12 schools, emphasis in multicultural and/or nontraditional approaches to education, emphasis upon interdisciplinary study and its implications for educational theory, research, and practice. Candidates for the scholarship must be nominated by a member of the faculty in the Department of Educational Leadership and Policy. Full or part-time students are eligible.
