Marjean Larson Ballard Scholarship

Available to:	(1) Juniors, seniors and graduate students, (2) who have been admitted to teacher education programs, and (3) have a 3.0 GPA or better
Value:	Cash award of \$1,000 for two semesters for a total of \$2,000
# of Awards:	One
Provided by:	Howard A. Ballard
Special Conditions:	Recipients must complete 12 credit hours (if undergraduate), or 9 hours (if graduate), per semester and maintain a 3.0 cumulative GPA.

Mary Elizabeth Baum Hanks Scholarship

Available to:	(1) Matriculated students, (2) pursuing a degree in Elementary Education, and (3) with a 3.3 cumulative GPA or better
Supporting Documentation:	(1) Indication that applicant has a record of good school citizenship and no prior history of use or sale of illegal drugs, written by applicant
Value:	Cash award of \$1,000 for two semesters for a total of \$2,000
# of Awards:	Three
Provided by:	Ida Mae Hanks
Special Conditions:	Recipient must apply annually. Students must have a record of "good school citizenship" and no prior history of the use or sale of illegal drugs. Awardees must be U.S. citizens, and preference will be given to non-residents from Idaho. If no Idaho students qualify, then the award may be given to any non-resident student. Recipients must complete minimum of 12 hours per semester and maintain a 3.3 cumulative GPA.

The M. Lynn and Katherine S. Bennion Scholarship

Available to:	Deserving undergraduate students who are (1) descendants of the donor or (2) minority students or (3) other students who are applicants for or are enrolled in a teacher education program at the College of Education and who need financial assistance.
Supporting Documentation:	(1) Descendants must document in a letter their relationship to M. Lynn and Katherine Bennion and will be given first consideration, (2) Analysis of financial need from the U of U Financial Aid Office
Value:	\$1,250 for two semesters applied towards tuition for a total of \$2,500 per year applied toward tuition
# of Awards:	One or Two (Varies)
Provided by:	M. Lynn and Katherine S. Bennion Foundation
Special Conditions:	Recipient must apply annually. Recipients must complete a minimum of 12 hours per semester and maintain a 3.0 cumulative GPA.

Dr. D.H. and Catherine Dean Christensen Scholarship

Available to:	(1) Graduate or undergraduate students (including incoming freshman), (2) admitted to the University of Utah, (3) resident or nonresident, and (4) pursuing teacher certification. Preference among equally qualified candidates will be given to single parents who are heads of households. Applicants must demonstrate need and have a good academic record.
Supporting Documentation:	(1) Statement of need and status as head-of-household, single parent (if applicable)
Value:	Cash award of \$1,000 for two semesters for a total of \$2,000
# of Awards:	Four
Provided by:	Dr. Dean K. Christensen and Helen Stallings Christensen
Special Conditions:	Students must reapply annually. Recipient must be registered as a full-time student. It is the donors' desire that once a recipient becomes a professional teacher and is financially capable, that the recipient repay to the scholarship fund up to one-half of the amount s/he received.

Departmental Scholarship

Available to:	(1) Resident entering freshman, sophomore, junior, and senior students (including junior college transfers), (2) who intend to pursue a career in teaching, (3) with a 3.5 GPA (cumulative) or better, and (4) applicants must be admitted to the University of Utah.
Value:	Tuition waiver fall & spring semesters (does <u>not</u> pay mandatory student or special fees) for one year. Maximum coverage is 15 credit hours each semester.
# of Awards:	Varies, in the past 4 to 5 scholarships have been awarded
Provided by:	The University of Utah
Special Conditions:	Awardees can reapply annually. Available to students pursuing first degree only. Recipients must complete 12 credit hours per semester and maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.5.

Kennecott Scholarship

Available to:	(1) Undergraduate students, juniors and seniors, and (2) admitted to teacher education programs who rank in the top 10% of education students (cumulative GPA).
Value:	Cash award varies by year, approximately \$2,000 for one year
# of Awards:	Two students in the College of Education: one from <u>elementary education</u> and one from <u>secondary education</u> .
Provided by:	Kennecott Corporation
Special Conditions:	Recipients must complete at least 24 credit hours within three continuous semesters and maintain a 3.5 GPA.

Ruth Lundgren Endowed Scholarship Fund

Available to:	Given to (1) students who have excelled academically (2) who are in need of financial assistance, and (3) must be in the top 25% of their class. (According to the gift agreement, the Lundgren Scholarship should be given to a student in the Early Childhood Program.)
Supporting Documentation:	(1) Analysis of financial need from the U of U Financial Aid Office
Value:	Cash award of \$750 per semester for a total of \$1,500
# of Awards:	One
Provided by:	Ruth Lundgren

Math/Science/Foreign Language Scholarship

Available to:	(1) Students admitted to the Secondary Teacher Education Program, (2) with teaching majors or minors in mathematics, one of the sciences (biology, chemistry, computer science, geology, or physics), or one of the foreign languages (French, German, Russian, or Spanish), and (3) who have a cumulative 3.0 GPA.
Value:	Award of \$750 each for two semesters for a total of \$1,500, applied to tuition.
# of Awards:	Five
Provided by:	Anne Taylor Dee Foundation (in part)
Special Conditions:	Recipients must maintain a cumulative 3.0 GPA on a minimum of 12 credit hours (if undergraduate), or 9 hours (if graduate) per semester.

John Vernon Harry and Shizuko Nakagawa Harry Endowed Scholarship Fund

Available to:	(1) Undergraduate and graduate students, (2) enrolled at the University of Utah, and (3) with a minimum GPA of 3.0. Preference will be given to those involved with secondary education.
Supporting Documentation:	(1) One-page essay about an influential secondary school teacher
Value:	Cash award of \$1,250 for two semesters for a total of \$2,500
# of Awards:	Four
Provided by:	Shuziko Harry
Special Conditions:	Recipient must apply annually. Recipient must maintain a cumulative 3.0 GPA and a minimum of 12 credit hours (if undergraduate), or 9 hours (if graduate) per semester.

Geneve C. Nelson Scholarship

Available to:	(1) Students admitted to the Elementary Education Licensure Program and (2) a 3.0 cumulative GPA or better.
Supporting Documentation:	(1) Statement of financial need, written by applicant
Value:	Cash award of \$375 for two semesters for a total of \$750
# of Awards:	One
Provided by:	Geneve C. Nelson
Special Conditions:	Recipient must apply annually. Recipients must complete a minimum of 12 hours per semester and maintain a 3.0 cumulative GPA. Selection criteria shall include financial need.

Milan S. Papulak Memorial Scholarship Fund

Available to:	For (1) a woman or minority student and (2) preparing to teach mathematics or science in a junior or senior high school. Graduate students are given first priority. If all applicants are equal, preference should be given to a qualifying non-traditional student.
Supporting Documentation:	(1) Statement of financial need, written by applicant
Value:	Cash award of \$1,000 per semester for a total of \$2,000
# of Awards:	Two
Provided by:	Kay Papulak
Special Conditions:	Recipient must apply annually. Recipient must complete a minimum of 12 hours per semester and maintain a 3.3 cumulative GPA.

Ada M. Roper Memorial Scholarship Fund

Available to:	(1) Juniors, (2) resident or non-resident, (3) pursuing a degree in Elementary Education, (4) who show financial need, and (4) must have at least a 3.0 Cumulative GPA.
Supporting Documentation:	(1) Statement of financial need, written by applicant
Value:	Cash award of \$2,000 for two semesters for a total of \$4,000
# of Awards:	One
Provided by:	The Meldrum Foundation
Special Conditions:	Recipient must complete a minimum of 12 hours per semester and maintain a 3.0 Cumulative GPA. Recipient must provide photograph to give to the donor. To be eligible to renew the scholarship for the recipient's senior year, the eligibility must continue to be met.

Joseph and Evelyn B. Rosenblatt Scholarship for Teachers

Available to:	(1) Practicing teachers <u>or</u> currently enrolled teacher education candidates, (2) who have been admitted to teacher education programs in the College of Education at the University of Utah, and (3) who desire to pursue the University of Utah's ESL/Bilingual teaching minor or endorsement, or who wish to enroll in course work focusing on meeting the needs of students who are "at risk" for school failure.
Supporting Documentation:	(1) Practicing teachers must submit a copy of their teaching license and current contract, (2) Statement describing why applicant wants to work with ESL/Bilingual or at-risk students, (3) Documentation of intent to complete ESL minor or endorsement
Value:	Cash award of \$1,000 for two semesters for a total of \$2,000
# of Awards:	Two
Provided by:	Joseph and Evelyn B. Rosenblatt
Special Conditions:	Students must apply annually. Applicants will be selected based on their academic abilities, commitment to improving the learning and achievement of "at risk" students, and potential to make a lasting impact in the lives of the children they will serve. Preference will be given to applicants pursuing the University of Utah's ESL/Bilingual teaching minor or endorsement, followed by those enrolled in course work focusing on meeting the needs of students who are "at risk" for school failure.

Stewart School Scholarship

Available to:	(1) Resident or nonresident, (2) graduate student, and (3) pursuing an advanced program in classroom teaching. Preference will be given to applicants who exhibit the potential to have a strong, positive influence on education in the State of Utah through creative teaching and research that elevates the teaching profession, enhances the learning of Utah's school children, and carries forward the philosophy and goals espoused by the founders of the Stewart School.
Value:	Cash award of \$1,000 for two semesters for a total of \$2,000
# of Awards:	Three
Provided by:	William M. Stewart School Alumni
Special Conditions:	Recipients must be admitted to a Department of Teaching & Learning graduate program by October 1 of the year the award is received.
